Rebuilding Together is a volunteer organization that works in partnership with the community to address the needs of low-income homeowners, primarily the elderly, disabled, and families with children. Recipients of services are those who have worked hard to own their own homes but whose failing health or fixed income does not allow them to cover the extraordinary costs of home repair.

St. Francis has participated every year from 2003 through 2014, but were back again in 2016. We have built a wheelchair ramp, done numerous plumbing and electrical repairs, replaced a roof, made structural repairs, cleaned up yards that were overgrown with shrubs and trees, applied many, many gallons of paint, and made minor improvements that allowed the occupants to live in warmth, safety, and independence. We are hoping to be able to participate again this year.
